CE MARK POLICY

CE marking indicates a product's compliance with EU legislation and so enables the free movement of products within the European market. By affixing the CE marking to a product, a manufacturer declares that the product satisfies the applicable legislative requirements enabling it to be sold.

NB: Not all products must bear the CE marking - only product categories mentioned in specific EU directives.

The CE Mark provides assurance that the manufacturer has verified that the product complies with all relevant essential requirements laid down in the applicable directive(s) and if stipulated in the directive(s), had it examined by an independent conformity assessment body.

Allfix Ltd believe the CE Marking Directives and the policies the company have adopted is an excellent way to strengthen relationships with our customers and to ensure the safer use of the products we distribute.

It is the manufacturer's responsibility to carry out the conformity assessment, to set up the technical file, to issue the declaration of conformity and to affix the CE marking.

As a distributor, Allfix Limited will, where requested, conduct checks to ensure that requisite products bear the CE marking and the supporting documentation is in order.

Our ISO:9001:2008 certified Quality Management System is formatted to ensure that in those instances where a customer informs the company, in writing, of their need to receive CE marked goods, systems are in place at the order processing/contract review stage to ensure such items are compliant.

Allfix Limited is not in the position to give legally binding information and any information you receive is what the OEM/Supplier has provided to us. As such, we cannot accept liability for financial losses (indemnity, loss of profit) or civil penalties caused by official ruling.

Allfix Limited will continually review directives and can assure all our customers compliance in the controls process currently adopted.

This policy will be regularly reviewed by the Directors and amended and updated as and when necessary.
