

REACH POLICY

The REACH Regulations comprise an integrated system for the registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemicals. The Directive includes annexes, which are under constant revision, listing 'Substances of Very High Concern' (SVHCs) such as carcinogens or substances considered very harmful to the environment.

Allfix Limited believe the REACH Regulations and the policies the company have adopted provide an excellent way to strengthen relationships with our customers and to ensure the safer use of the products we distribute.

As a responsible distributor, supplying to our customers a range of sealants, resins and other chemical products, the company maintain an approved list of supply sources, i.e. those known to provide items that comply with the REACH regulations.

Written statements, specific to the REACH Regulations, have been sourced from all of our REACH approved suppliers.

Our ISO:9001:2008 certified Quality Management System is formatted to ensure that in those instances where a customer informs the company, in writing, of their need to receive goods that are REACH compliant, systems are in place at the order processing/contract review stage to ensure such items are sourced from the approved REACH compliant organisations.

New suppliers being sourced for products that are affected by the REACH Regulations will be subject to pre-approval processes and checks for compliancy.

Under the REACH regulations, Allfix Limited, as a downstream user, has an obligation to provide information to the user if a product contains an SVHC in a concentration greater than 0.1% by weight. We will fulfil this general obligation by passing to our customers any relevant information received from our suppliers, where requested.

This policy will be regularly reviewed by the Directors and amended and updated as and when necessary.
