

RoHS POLICY

The Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive (2011/65/EU) sets maximum acceptable levels of 6 substances within the composition of the product – lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium and both polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants - in all electrical and electronic products, and their component parts, placed on the market after 1st July 2006, with certain exceptions.

Allfix Limited believe the RoHS Regulations and the policies the company have adopted provide an excellent way to strengthen relationships with our customers and to ensure the safer use of the products we distribute.

As a responsible distributor, supplying to our customers a range of electrical products, compliance of the components we supply is ensured during the buying process and if required, Allfix Limited will send confirmation of the current status.

Our ISO:9001:2008 certified Quality Management System is formatted to ensure that in those instances where a customer informs the company, in writing, of their need to receive goods that are RoHS compliant, systems are in place at the order processing/contract review stage to ensure such items are compliant.
